



Advanced Placement and International Credentials

Eastern encourages prospective students to challenge themselves and welcomes those who have gone above and beyond in their high school academics by taking Advanced Placement courses. As a result of having already successfully completed college-level work, some students can be admitted with advanced standing at the university.

We do not currently offer credit for or International Baccalaureate courses.

Homeschooled Students

You need a composite ACT score of at least 17 or an SAT score of at least 810 for regular admission.

In addition to your home schooled transcript and your ACT with Writing or SAT score, we strongly encourage home-schooled students to submit subject tests, AP exam scores, or grades from an accredited secondary or post-secondary institution in the academic subjects required for admission.

Learning Communities

A learning community is a group of 20–25 students who enroll in two or more courses together to explore a common interest or theme. You do not have to know what you want to major in to join a learning community. Learning communities are offered in a wide variety of themes and interests and include courses that meet general education requirements.

All entering freshmen are enrolled in a learning community when they register for classes. When you visit the [Advising Center](#), you and your advisor will decide which learning community is best for you. You must register for all the courses offered in the community.



For Adults Over 25

If you will be 25 years or older on your first day of classes at Eastern and have less than one year's worth (24 hours) of college work to transfer, you're considered an adult student for admission purposes. Your admission requirements are the same as a freshman, you just have a slightly different application process. You may also not be required to live on campus for your first year.

Dual Admission Degree (2+2) Programs

ENMU currently has agreements with Amarillo College, CNM–Albuquerque, Clovis Community College, ENMU Roswell and ENMU Ruidoso for a variety of Dual Admission Degree (2+2) programs. This means that your credits will transfer and you can earn your bachelor's when you transfer from one of these institutions, without losing any of your course credits to the transfer process.

Will My Courses Transfer to ENMU?

To be eligible for transfer credit, an approved course must be taken for a grade at an approved college and completed with a grade of C or better. ENMU's Transfer Equivalency Site (TES) is provided as a guide to how classes at your current or former school may transfer to ENMU. The fact that a course appears in the list is no guarantee that the course will transfer in your individual case. Final determination of transfer credit acceptance is ultimately made by the deans or department chairs, once a decision has been made on a transfer student application.





Graduate Students

The decision to begin graduate studies is an important one. Graduate study offers students the opportunity to learn, exchange innovative ideas, be part of a diverse educational community, challenge others while being challenged, and explore and solve current issues of your chosen profession.

Eastern New Mexico University offers 24 graduate degrees, three graduate certificates and 14 completely online graduate degrees. Graduates of a regionally accredited college or university, or whose institution is recognized by the Commission on Recognition of Post-secondary Accreditation (CORPA) may apply for admission to the ENMU Graduate School.

Admission to the Eastern New Mexico University Graduate School involves a two-step admission process including application and admission to the graduate school and admission to the specific graduate program.

International Students have a variety of options within the graduate program. However, the [International Graduate Student Procedures](#) are unique and must be followed to be admitted to the ENMU Graduate School.

Scholarships

Scholarships are defined as a type of financial aid, in the form of a grant (a sum of money or other aid) that does not have to be repaid by the recipients to assist students as they pursue their studies.

Scholarships are awarded by Enrollment Services, the ENMU Foundation and various academic departments to current and in-coming students. The office of Financial Aid administers these funds after they have been awarded.

Beginning freshmen and transfer students only need to fill out one scholarship application for all the scholarships.

To be considered for undergraduate admissions scholarship, the priority deadline is Aug. 1 for the fall semester and Jan. 3 for the spring semester.

In-State Freshman

If you're a resident of New Mexico, or Texas residents who live within 135 miles of Eastern, you qualify as an In-State Freshman.
